- 12 to return true bill








How Grand Juries Work

Handle a Document Subpoena differently from a testimonial subpoena

- Testimony perhaps a proffer
- Get relevant documents
- Is your client without sin
- That will require investigation
- The client may not think It is necessary to for all the work but it is



Target or Subject

- If your client is a subject or target, then the chances of your wanting him or her to speak with prosecutors is slim.
- Immunity
- Non-prosecution
- Cooperation





Document Subpoenas

- Status counts
- Issued to individual
- Corporate subpoena
- Grounds to quash



Gather the Documents

- Limit production via word searches negotiate terms
- Have client amass All DOCUMENTS
- Review all documents
- Categorize irrelevant/relevant/hot/privileged
- Discuss them with the client
- Bad documents have to go over absent a good reason





Remember...

- During document production:
- Bad documents are facts we have to deal with, not hide
- Lawyers get involved to assist clients with issues
- Not turning over relevant documents hurts the client
- Withholding documents for no good reason makes the problem your problem
